Main Idea/Summary	So many of us carry deep wounds. God wants to bring us healing.
Scripture	Malachi 4:5-6

QUESTIONS	
About God	We can know if God is speaking to us if the voice we hear aligns with this character, nature and Word in the Bible. If you have heard God speak to you, what did he say? What did the message reveal about his character, nature and Word?
About Me	Most of us are haunted by broken relationships with unresolved conflicts. Which relationships do you wish were totally healed today? What do you need to do so you can heal, forgive and find greater peace? (Remember, the pastoral care team is here for you.)
Community	If you keep in mind that most people have father or mother wounds, and most are haunted by unresolved conflicts, how might that change your mindset and actions in dealing with difficult people? Give a few examples.
Mission	What can you do to put Romans 12:18 into practice this week with difficult people? Brainstorm several ideas with your group. Consider Matt. 5:23-24 and Matt. 18:15 in your answers.
Action	Pastor Ron said, "Forgiveness is hard work, but it's work we all need to get to doing." What step will you take this week to move more toward being ready to forgive? How can looking at Jesus, forgiving you while he was on the cross, motivate you in letting go?

Father God, we praise you for being our perfect Father, who we can turn to for healing in our deepest trauma. We confess we have often chosen to ignore, lash out, defend ourselves or keep busy rather than asking you to help us forgive. Thank you for forgiving us while we were still sinners, out of your perfect love for us. Help us to love you more and love others well, seeking to heal and be reconciled in our broken relationships.
