Main Idea/Summary	We are sent to abide in Jesus, be attentive and responsive to God's promptings, and live as everyday missionaries.
Scriptures	Epheians 3:14-21, Matthew 28:16-20, John 15:5-8, Acts 1:8, Romans 8:15

QUESTIONS	
About God	Brett talked about how God is a "for the sake of others" kind of God. How does that fit with or challenge what you have heard or been taught about God in the past? What does it say about God that he sends us to be a part of his work in the world?
About Me	Can you talk a little bit about you are currently 1) abiding in Jesus, 2) being attentive and responsive to God's promptings, and 3) living as an everyday missionary? Where are you strong or weak right now?
Community	Who do you have in your life that could help you notice God's voice and work in your life? Is there anyone in your community that you see that lives as an everyday missionary?
Mission	Brett talked about giving God our "small yes" over and over again. What do you think this might look like for you? Can you give an example of when you might have done that well in the past?
Action	Take time to pray for one another based on the conversation from the questions above. Each person commit to pray for one other person in their group every day this week, and next time you meet ask how things have been going in the areas of abiding in Jesus, being attentive and responsive to God's promptings, and living as an everyday missionary. Encourage one other in your next steps.

Jesus, thank you that you invite us to be like you and live a "for the sake of others" life. Help us to draw our life from you and constantly give our life back to you, to be sensitive to you voice, and to offer your love in tangible ways to the world around us. Amen.
